



Wellow Neighbourhood Plan

Notes recording the main points agreed at the Neighbourhood Planning Team meeting on Monday
17th February 2020

Key points are as follows

Introduction There have been some more photos from the Drone loaded to the repository. Please note that the copywrite for these photos belongs to David Jessinger; therefore, we must be mindful to how we use the photos. Hampshire Collegiate School have given permission for drone pictures to be captured this week at the school; as it is half-term. Hampshire Collegiate School are lending Wellow NHP team 12 stands to be used at the community event. There is a new folder in the repository, titled 'Developer Correspondence'. Emails received from developers are saved here. Some preliminary results from the HNS have been received. There were about 550 responses. A summary of the key points was given at the meeting and is provided with these notes. It should be noted that this information is indicative at this stage as only a few of the questions were considered. The full report is due from Action Hampshire at the end of February	
Vision/themes/Policies The team have met twice in the last month to develop the policies and have got as far as they can, with the evidence available. They have met with Sharon and are now waiting for feedback. The work has identified some areas where further evidence may be required to support suggested policies. Agricultural workers accommodation, polytunnels, and solar farms are some of the areas.	
Community Event The advertising poster and information posters have been loaded to the repository for comment. The advertising poster (A4 size) has been printed in the Parish Office and shown at the meeting. All agreed that the colours were good and more copies can be made for the Parish notice boards. 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Charles and Thelma have met with Louise Bull from TVBC for some advice. It was agreed what boards would go in the Nightingale room and the main hall. It was also suggested that we have a welcome board in the entrance. Home-made cakes are required on the day, Thelma to coordinate. Please let Thelma know what you are going to make. It was suggested that we have Business cards to distribute; logo one side and face-book, website and email address the other. Suggested we have badges to wear on the day. A banner; 3m x 0.80m is being designed and it is planned to have it tied to the hedge in front of the hall. Adverts have been sent to the Romsey & Wellow Gazette, Parish Magazine and will be sent to the Romsey advertiser. On Friday 27th March, we hope to start preparing the stands and possibly move them into the hall after 8:30pm. The meeting looked at the poster designs and made comments. It was agreed that instead of having the full theme wording at the top, that just key words or phrases would be better. Some posters were too cluttered, some text was too small. Kathy to inform Chris that there would be further changes required. We will consider combining the 'Can' and 'Cannot do' posters. Kathy, Thelma and Charles to review posters with all this in mind. It was also suggested that some of the photos are removed from the posters and printed separately. Kathy to test getting a couple printed at the Parish Office. Sharon may have the policies for one theme ready by the day of the event. If so, we could have these printed, for viewing only. Economic Development / Business Evidence is still needed for policies for Economic development in the Parish. Les provided an overview of the work already done through an initial business survey in Spring 2018. The residents survey in autumn 2018, showed no strong feelings towards the businesses in the Parish.	



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Les has done a desktop study, of the businesses registered in the Parish. This suggests that they employ over 500 staff (excluding schools and agriculture). Economic development affects land use change so is an important aspect for the plan.
